**Required tools in bold** - others are recommended tools. They are available as a kit (see below).

Most of the tools are available locally at Michaels Stores, Utrecht, Prism, or Pat Catan's - but not all items may be available at every store. Check the polymer clay aisle, pottery clay aisle, and painting areas. Suggested kits below.

**Paintbrush - size #1-2 round watercolor, (sable or synthetic- need not be expensive)**

Taper point Colour Shaper size #0 or 2 (very useful)

**Flexible blade/tissue blade**

**Craft knife**

**Roller (acrylic/copper pipe/pvc pipe)**

**Playing cards or slats (slats available online)**

Work surface (styrene, Teflon -Teflex (like for baking or embossing - not silpat)

**Small spray bottle for water**

**Small watertight container for making slip**

**Emery boards/sanding sticks**

Brass brush (optional, instructor has some for use in class)

**Box to transport supplies and projects.** Artbin or other craft box.
